

Reimbursement for Hearing Aids: No Longer Paid on a “By Report” Basis

Effective July 1, 2026, reimbursement for hearing aids will no longer be paid on a “by report” basis.

Beginning July 1, 2026, hearing aids will be reimbursed according to the established fee schedule. Other Hearing aid equipment and services (i.e., dispensing fees, fittings, batteries, etc.) will continue to be reimbursed according to the established fee schedule.

Providers should refer to the [Wyoming Medicaid Fee Schedule](#) for reimbursement rates and the Wyoming Medicaid [CMS-1500 Provider Manual](#) for billing guidance.

This change is intended to standardize reimbursement and improve consistency and speed in payment processing.

Claims submitted for dates of service on or after July 1, 2026, will be processed based on the fee schedule rates in effect at the time of service.
