

Attention Wyoming Medicaid Clients

Effective August 1, 2012 the Medicaid co-payments will be increasing. The co-pay table below shows the new co-payment amounts.

In compliance with the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the following change has been made to the co-payment schedule, if you are a member of a Federally recognized Tribe or have ever received medical care at a Indian Health Service (I.H.S), Tribal Health Program or under contract health services from I.H.S you are exempt from the Medicaid co-pay.

If you have not reported to your Department of Family Services worker that you are a member of a Federally Recognized Tribe please contact your local office so your record can be updated with this information, otherwise if you have ever been seen at the I.H.S clinic in Ft. Washakie or Ethete you have already been listed as exempt.
